21		For Member of Board of Education (Vote for not more than 2)	Shall a tax levy substituting for existing levies be imposed by the West Geauga Local School District for the purpose of providing for the necessary requirements of the school district in the initial sum of \$6,050,000, and a levy of taxes be made outside of the ten-mill limitation estimated by the county auditor to require 4.82 mills for each \$1 of taxable value, which amounts to \$169 for each \$100,000 of the county auditor's appraised value for the initial year of the tax, for a continuing period of time, commencing in 2025, first due in calendar year 2026, with the sum of such tax to increase only if and as new land or real property improvements not previously taxed by the school district are added to its tax list? A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Geauga County Job and Family Services for the purpose of any operating or capital improvement expenditure necessary for the support of children services and the care and placement of children that the county auditor estimates will collect \$2,331,346 annually, at a rate not exceeding 0.7 mill for each \$1 of taxable value, which amounts to \$15 for each \$100,000 of the county auditor's appraised value, for 5 years, commencing in 2026, first due in calendar year 2027. <input type="radio"/> For the Tax Levy <input type="radio"/> Against the Tax Levy	17 Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal and Increase) Gauga County Park District A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.
